
Small Promethean Acts: small sculpture using found objects and stoneware figures that celebrate invisible domestic acts

AUT VIAM INVENIAM AUT FACIAM (I will find a way or make one), 23x17x17cm, found paint tin with ceramic figure


Boys and their toys, 20x10x8cm, found cornice, figure, domino brick, plastic ball, toy gun and army truck with ceramic figure
